The school has been given a certificate for coming third in the Kagera Region's rankings of all schools in 2013.

Five students were also chosen to continue onto form 5 at other Secondary Schools in Tanzania. This is the first time this has happened since the school opened. The Headmistress and Staff are to be congratulated.

All the Form II students passed their National exams and now continue on to Form III for 2014 year. They were ranked third out of 27 schools in the Region.

This year the EdAid Board is sponsoring 40 students for half their school fees.

This will enable the students to complete their year's study. Often parents do not have the means to pay for the second half years' fees, and students are taken out of the School and cannot complete the year. We hope that by paying the second half years fees this can be avoided.
